What is this fundraiser?

From late September thru October, anyone wishing to drop off Black Walnuts to the library is welcome to do so. We prefer that the walnuts are bagged and not dumped on the ground. Unbagged walnuts may be taken to 1048 Campbell Road.

What then?

The Friends Group delivers the walnuts to a buyer and receives \$13/100 pounds.

Where do the funds go?

The funds are used for programs and to purchase books and other materials for the library.

Funds raised:

Between 2001 and 2012, the Friends Group has raised \$3,747.77.

This year due to the work involved with this fundraiser we have asked the Alganssee Farm Boosters 4-H Club to help us and will be splitting the funds with them this year.
