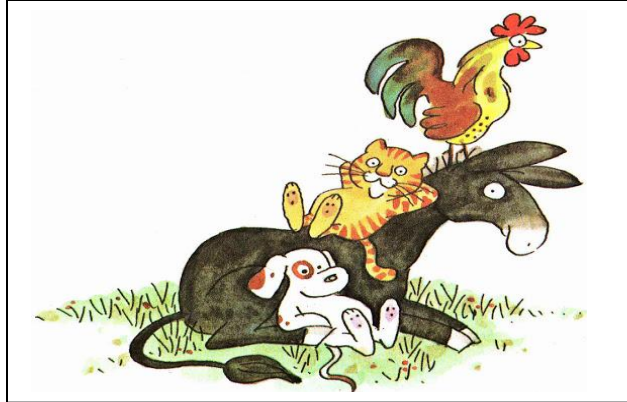


The little matadors and bulls had a great time learning Spanish, doing a fine art project and bull fighting...olé!

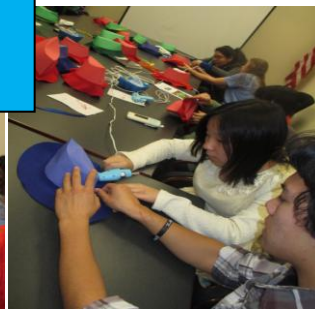
# Traveling Tales
