

Back on June 20, 2016, the BDL Board approved Kimberly Feltner's application to take advantage of the Library's Tuition Reimbursement program as she pursued her Master's Degree in Library Science. Kimberly graduated from Wayne State University on August 18, 2017.

Item 7 of the Agreement signed by all parties states:
