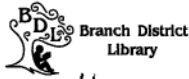

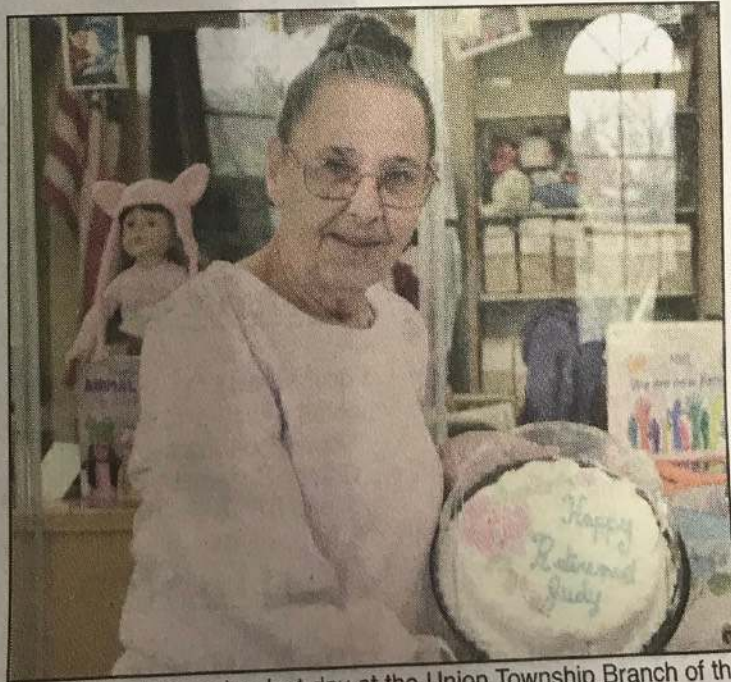
Judy Gottschalk retired from the Branch District Library last Friday. An Open House was held for community members to wish Gottschalk well on her retirement.
