As you will notice on the reservation card, there are a very limited number of single rooms and rooms without bath at Grand Hotel. Most of their accommodations are double rooms with bath. Suites are available at the convention rates for groups desiring connecting rooms. Those requiring such accommodations please write the Chairman of the Reservation Committee, stating your desires. To avoid duplication we insist that you give the name of each individual to occupy the suite.

There are twenty-one other hotels on the Island, all within easy walking distance of the Grand Hotel. They are all attractive, clean comfortable places, affording prompt and courteous service.

The rates we have obtained make it possible for you to attend this convention for less total cost than any other convention you have attended. Perhaps an explanation will make this clear.

First, most all of the entertainment is furnished without charge by Grand Hotel, making it possible for us to reduce the registration fee one-half. This year your registration fee will be \$1.25 instead of \$2.50. Rates at the Grand Hotel are quoted on the American plan, which includes all meals-luncheons-banquets-bridge teas, etc. These are items for which you have always paid extra. Rates at the 21 other hotels are quoted on the European plan in order that you may attend luncheons, banquets, etc. at the Grand Hotel.
