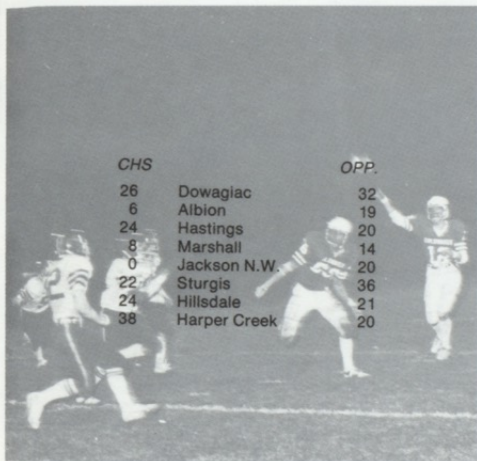

While there were no major team milestones reached, individual goals were accomplished.

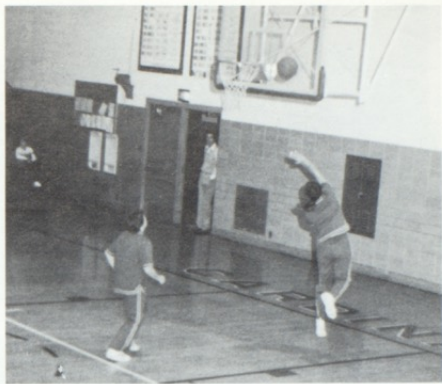

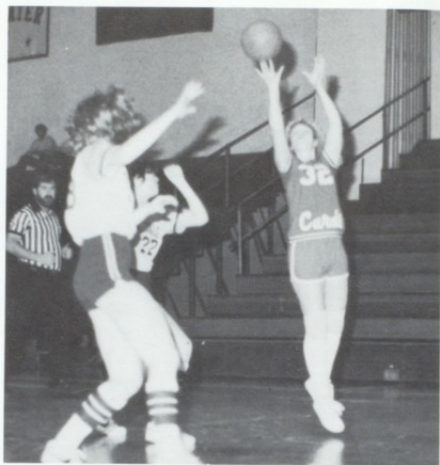

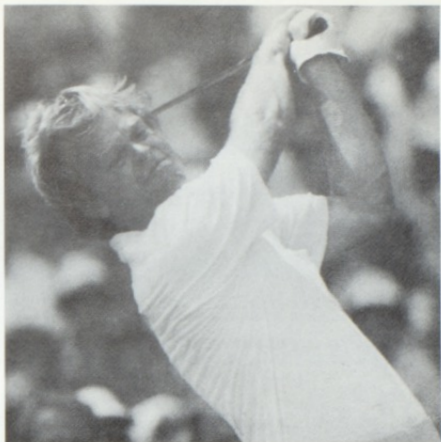

For the first time ever in C.H.S. history, the Cardinal squad escaped the league season undefeated! They finished the season in 2nd place behind Sturgis, the league champs.

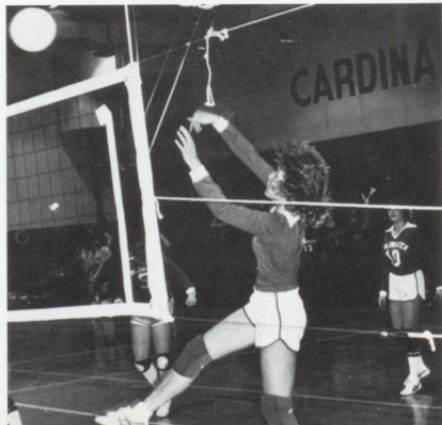
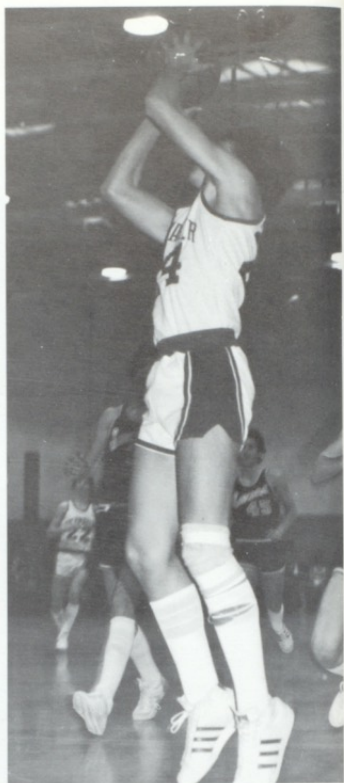
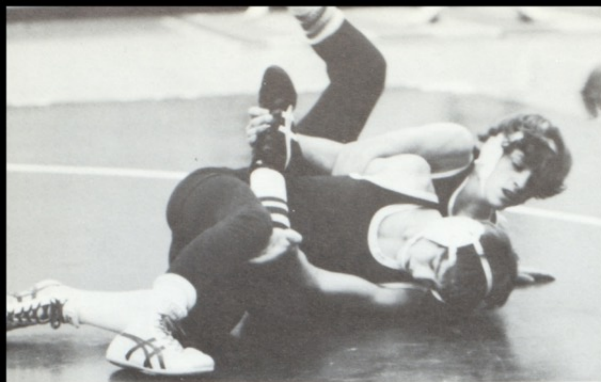

Next year's team will have more experience behind them and with the dedication Coach Neitzert shows toward the sport, the Lady Spikers will be heard.

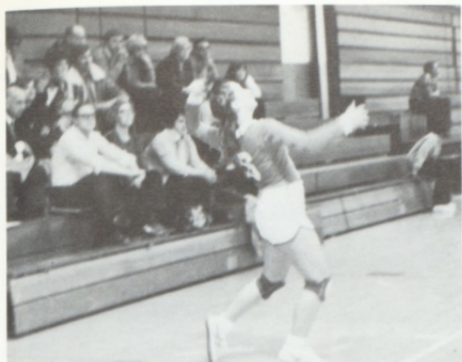

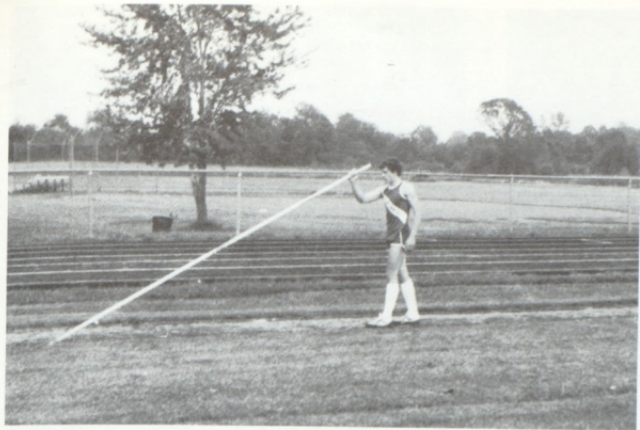
Bret Norton picked up valuable points throughout the season and missed breaking the mile record by .2 seconds. Bret finished second in the conference mile.

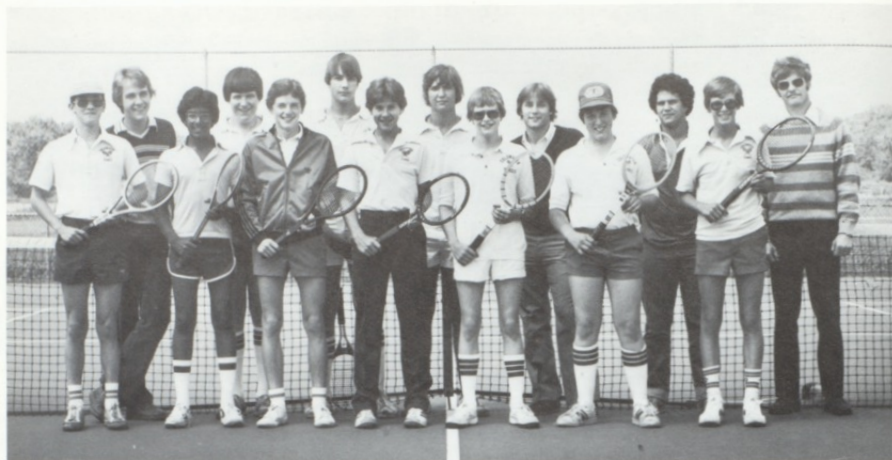

With several underclassmen returning in events such as the shot put, discus, 440m, and distance events, Coach Billsborrow has much to look forward to.



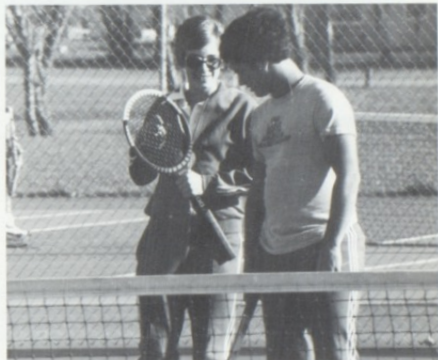
