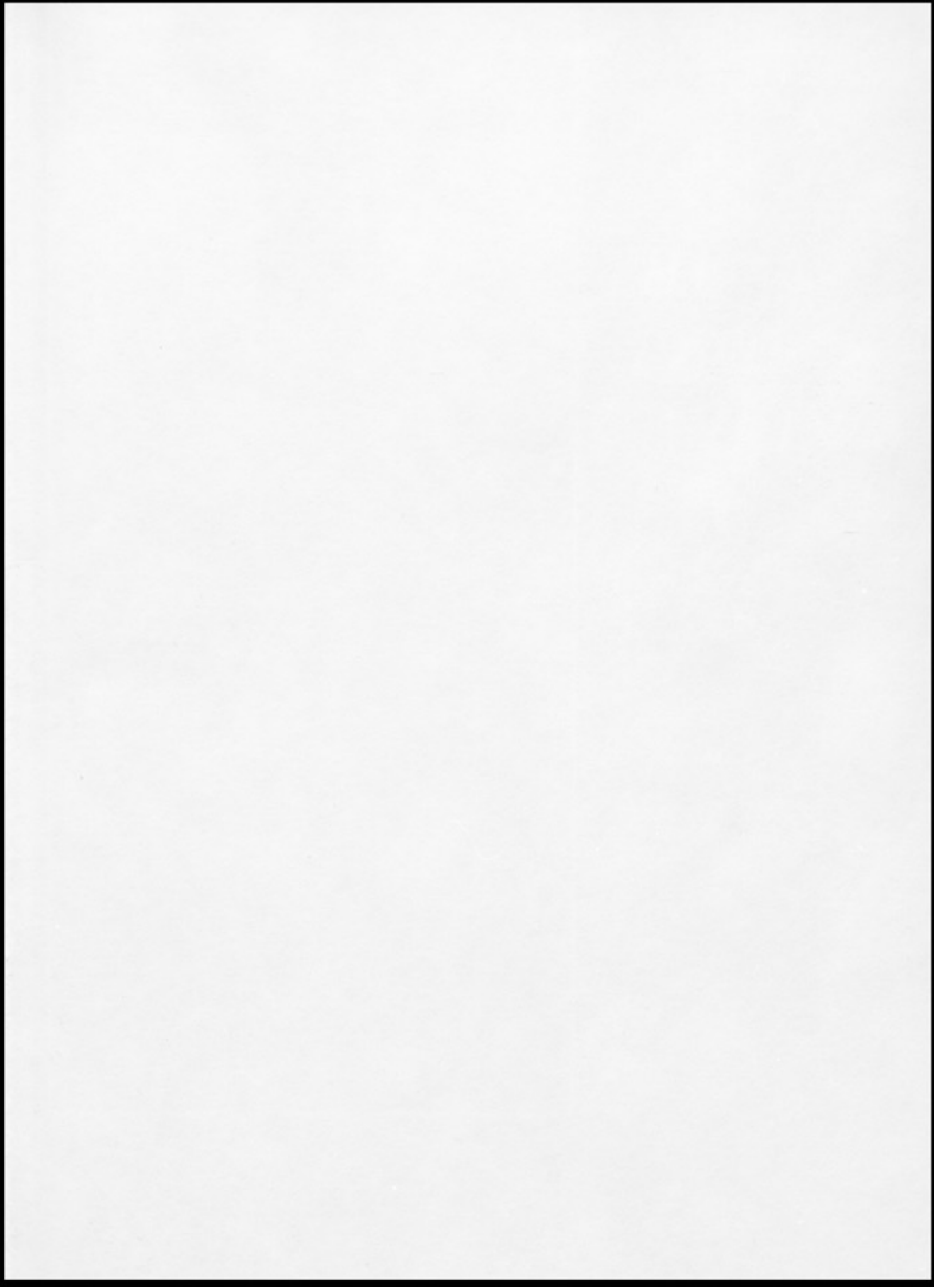

Because of her devotion to the Bronson community, she is much respected by all.



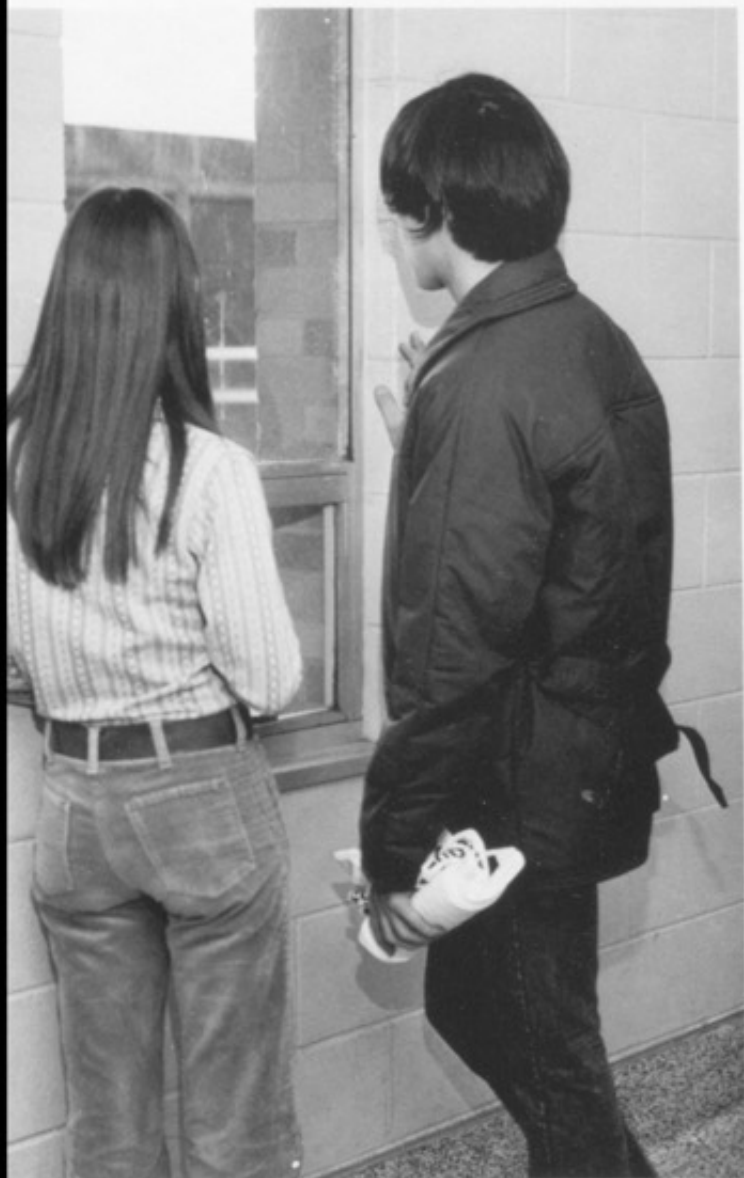
