Excerpt from International By-Laws

Article IX, Section 10: Any chartered club of not more than forty-nine (49) active, reserve, and privileged members when unable to send a delegate to any Annual Convention held outside of its convention zone, may be represented for attendance purposes thereat by the delegate of another club of not more than forty-nine (49) such members in the same district or by delegates of the nearest club of not more than forty-nine (49) members in an adjoining state or province, provided that such delegate shall not represent more than two clubs other than his own and shall have only one vote in the convention, and provided that his expenses are borne by the said clubs pro-rated according to the number of active, reserve and privileged members of such clubs. The arrangements for such representation shall be made not less than sixty (60) days prior to the date of any Annual Convention and shall be certified by a certificate duly authenticated by the president and secretary of each club. In the event that any chartered club desiring to make arrangements for such representation shall fail to certify such arrangements, then the Committee on Credentials shall have the right to determine the representation of such chartered club at the convention.
