AMENDMENTS TO STANDARD FORM FOR CLUB BY-LAWS

The by-laws of the Coldwater, Mecligan club have been revised to read as follows:

Article III, Section 2 (a) -- This subsection should be changed by inserting after the words "community standing" the words "residing, having community interests in, or" so that the amended section shall read:

- (a) The active membership of this club shall consist of men of good character and community standing, residing, having community interests in, or engaged in recognized lines of business, agricultural, institutional, and professional life, within the territorial limits of the club, and,
 - (1) who are owners or partners;
 - (2) who are executives, corporate officers, or managers with administrative duties and discretionary authority;
 - (3) who, as district or local agents or branch representatives, are in entire charge of such agency or branch in an executive capacity; or
 - (4) who are engaged in any worthy and recognized profession, for which they have received the recognized standard education.

Amend Article III, Section 2 (b) of the Standard Form for Club By-laws by changing the period to a comma at the end of the section and adding the words "or shall reside or have community interests therein," so that the said subsection shall read:

(b) Each active member shall personally devote, within the territorial limits of the club, sixty per cent (60%) of his occupational time to the vocational activity under which he is classified, or shall reside, or have community interests therein.

Amend Article III, Section 2 (f) of the Standard Form for Club By-laws by inserting after the words "remove his vocational activity" the words "residence and community interests," so that said subsection shall read:

(f) Active membership shall automatically cease in case any active member shall retire or shall permanently remove his vocational activity, residence, and community interests from the territorial limits of the club or shall change his vocational activity so as to be ineligible for active membership under the classification in which he was formerly listed. If he shall so retire, he may be elected a privileged member, or if he shall so change his vocational activity, he may be elected a reserve member, as hereinafter provided. If he shall so remove from the territorial limits of this club, he shall receive from the Secretary a certificate of withdrawal if in good standing.

Amend Article III, Section 3 (a) of the Standard Form for Club By-laws by inserting after the words "transferring his vocational activity" the words "residence and community interests," so that said subsection shall read:

(a) Any man who has been an active or a reserve member of another Kiwanis club up to the time of permanently transferring his vocational activity, residence, and community interests to the territorial limits of this club, and who, because his classification is filled, cannot become an active member of the club, may, upon presentation of his certificate of withdrawal, be elected a reserve member under the classification for the vocational activity to which he devotes sixty per cent (60%) of his occupational time as owner, partner, or executive as defined for active membership. In case a vacancy occurs in active membership under the classification for the vocational activity in which said reserve member is engaged, his reserve membership shall automatically cease; but he may be elected to active membership.

Amend Article III, Section 3 (d) of the Standard Form for Club By-laws by inserting after the words "remove his vocational activity" the words "residence and community interests," so that said subsection shall read:

(d) Reserve membership in the club shall automatically cease in case any reserve member shall retire or shall permanently remove his vocational activity, residence, and community interests from the territorial limits of the club or shall change his vocational activity so as to be ineligible for reserve membership under the classification in which he has been formerly listed. In such case he shall receive from the Secretary a certificate of withdrawal if in good standing.
