Around 1959 Sally Merchant began a teaching career that would span nearly 20 years. During those early years she taught science in the Middle School. In the mid-70's, she became involved with the importance of cardio-pulmonary resuscitation and was a leader in developing a program for teaching CPR to her students and the residence of Branch County. Sally served on the Branch County CPR Board, the Substance Abuse Council for Branch and Calhoun Counties, was coordinator for drug education for UCHS, and was a member of the team responsible for a career education program for the Calhoun Intermediate School District. In May of 1981 Sally received the first "Citizen of the Year" award from the community of Union City for her work with the CPR program as well as other contributions to education and the service of the community.

Sally was good at what she did. She was able to relate to all students, whether they were "A" students or a student having great difficulties, on a one to one basis. Her courage and will power were a great inspiration to many of us who knew her. We will all miss Sally, but we are richer for having known her and shared in her life.

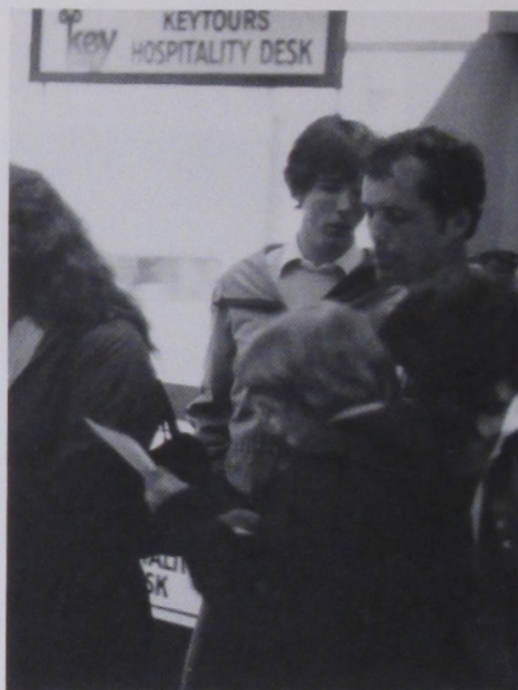


Seniors Take Toronto By Storm!
