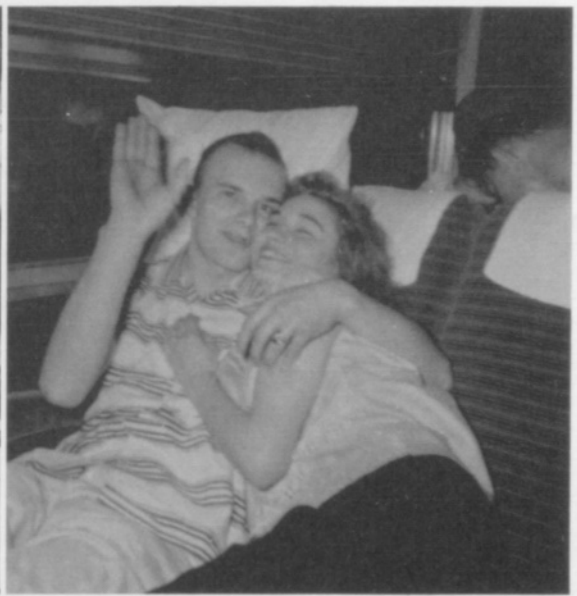
THESPIAN TROUPE 620

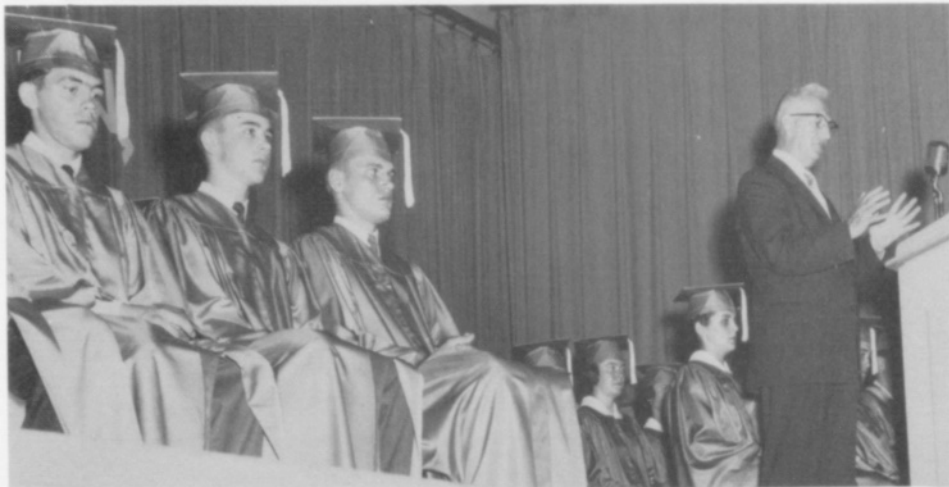

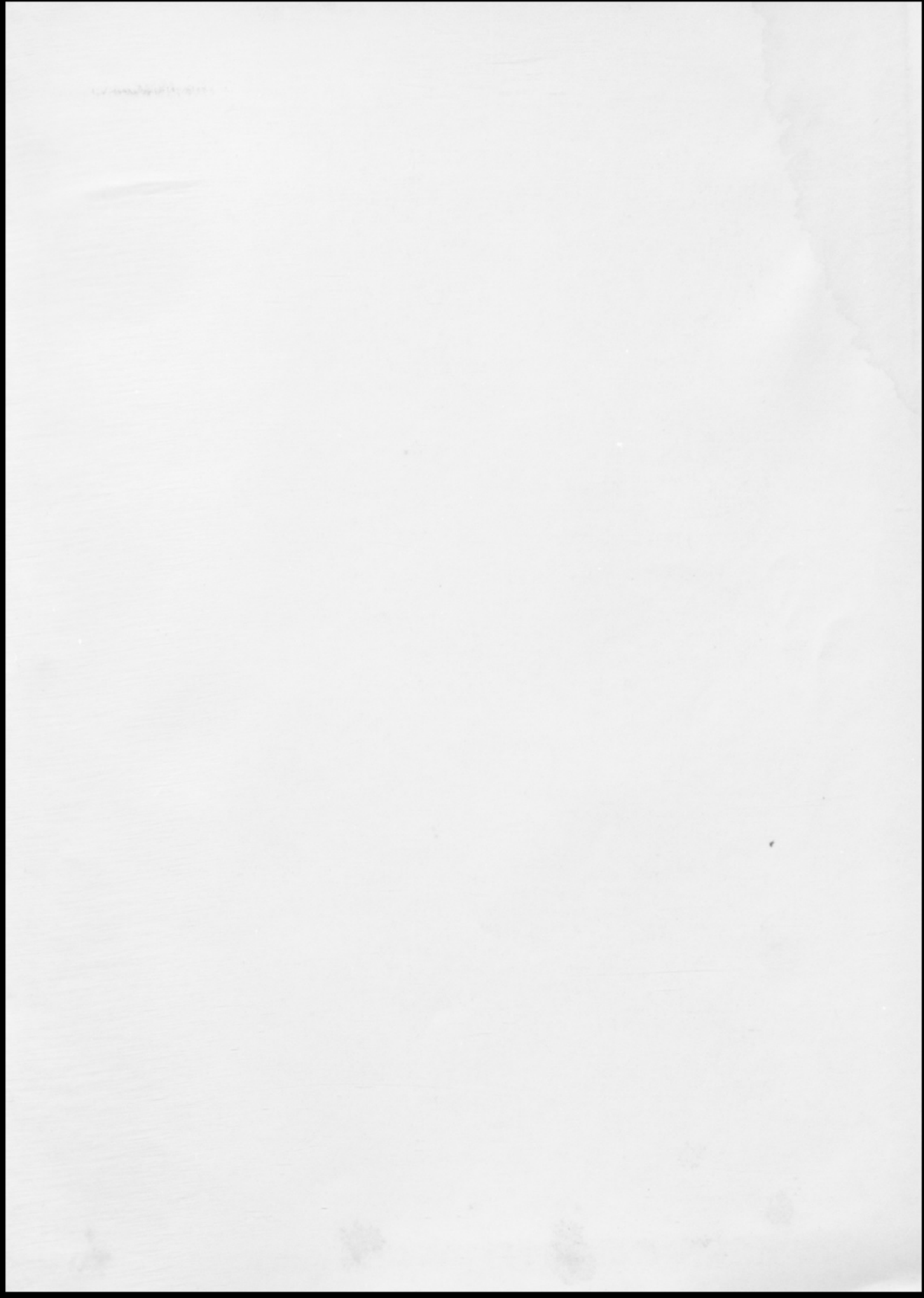
