Commission Strives To Make CHS More Interesting, Exciting



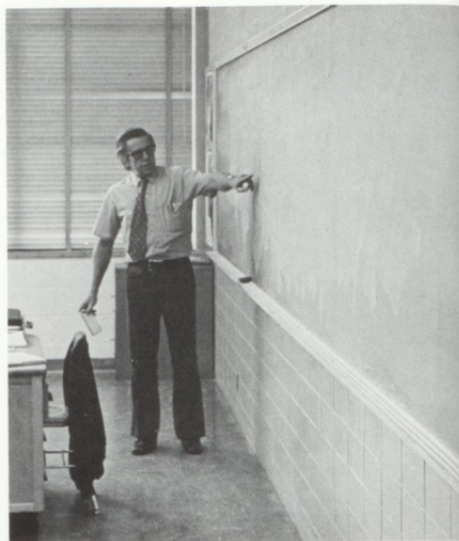

It's been great! The Commission can really be proud of their accomplishments in 1975.

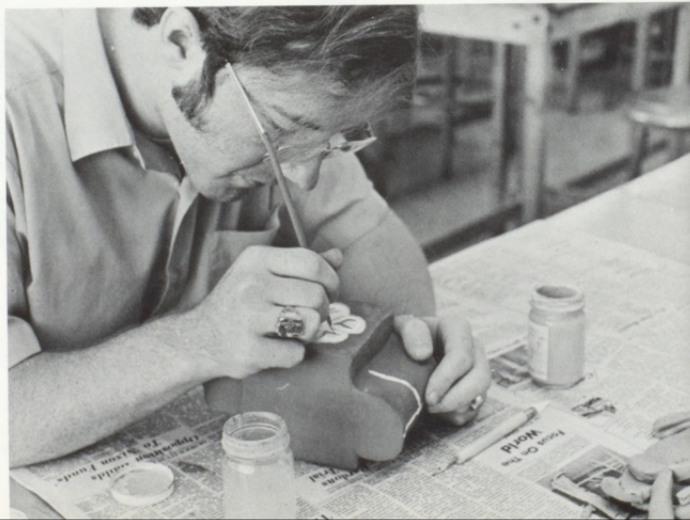

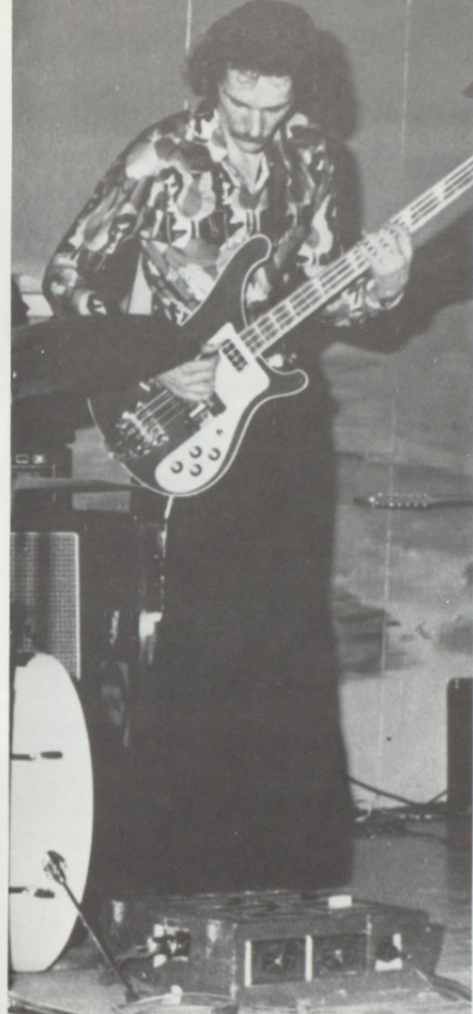
'74 Prom — You Are The Sunshine Of My Life

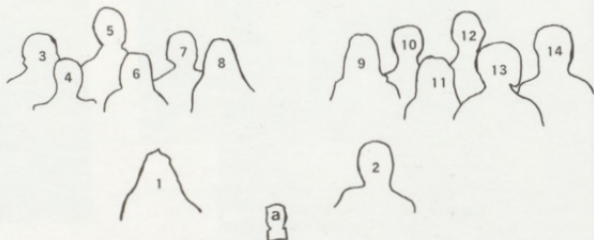

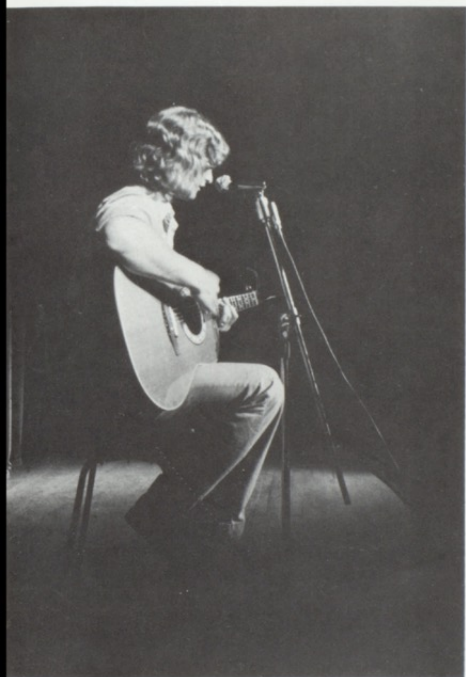

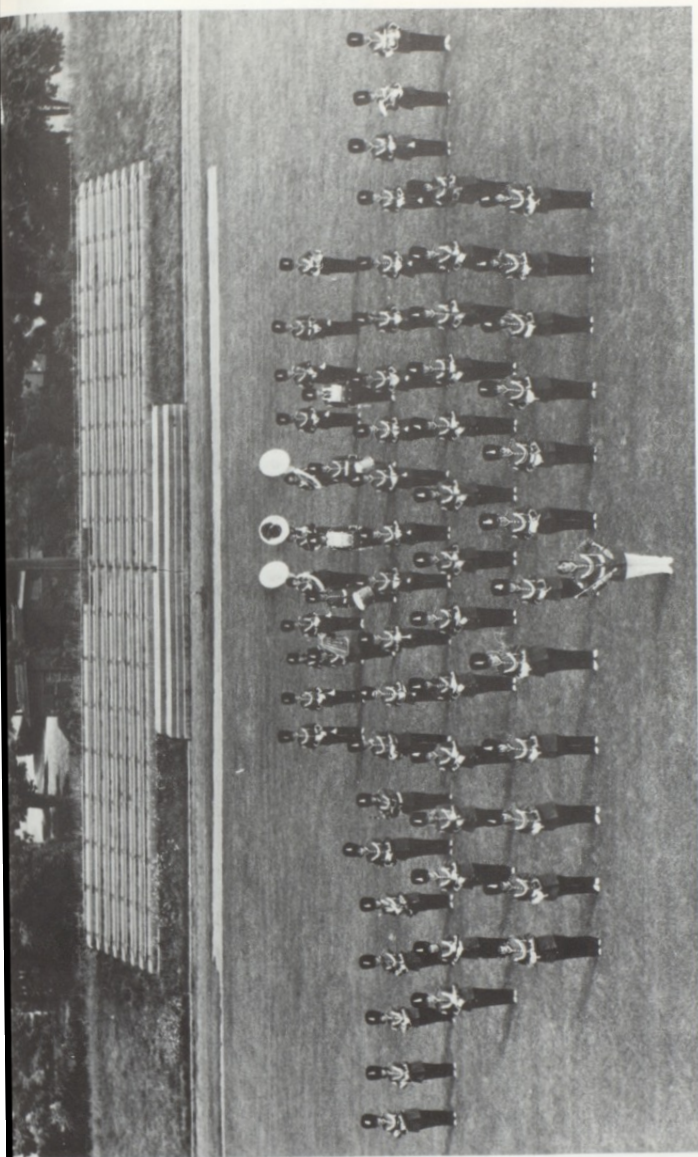
