BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

- 1. Bad language, loudness, teasing, bullying, roughhousing, and rudeness will not be tolerated. You will be asked to leave if any of this occurs. Be respectful of library staff and other library visitors.
- 2. You must sit in a seat at a computer; only one person should use one seat at a time. Do not mistreat furniture.
- 3. Library cards are required to reserve time on a computer. Guest passes are available only for those visiting from outside our service area.
- 4. Daily computer time is limited so more people have an opportunity to use the computer lab. During busy times, sessions will be shortened.
- 5. Inappropriate behavior at/on the computers may result in loss of computer privileges.
- 6. Tablet computers are available for our youngest patrons and their caregivers. If you are not in this group you will be asked to leave the tablet area.
- 7. Keep your belongings with you at all times. This includes: backpacks, homework, musical instruments, etc. The library is not responsible for your belongings.
- 8. Beverages with lids and food may be consumed only in designated areas.
- 9. Volume on technology devices must be silenced. Earbuds/headphones must be used if volume is needed in the library.
- 10. You must follow the Code of Conduct Policy (BranchDistrictLibrary.org/policies); anyone not using the library for its designated purpose will be asked to leave. These activities include: studying, reading a book or magazine, using a computer or the wifi, attending a library program, or working on coloring pages/activity sheets.
- 11.If behavior during a library program is inappropriate, staff may ask you to leave.
