# What Services Does the Algansee Branch Have to Offer?

There are 7,387 Total Items in Library as of February 2014 that are available for checkout and/or for review at the library. This includes Books, DVD's, Audio Books, and Magazines.

DVD's have a 7 day check out; while Magazines are 14 days. Books range from 14 days to 4 weeks.

Three computers are for public use as well as 2 laptops

There is a color printer/copier available for 15cents for black and white copies or 25 cents for color copies.

We now have the capability to fax documents as well. Cost is \$1/page

Most items are available for checkout with the exception of some reference materials. Stop in at the library and see all the amazing items that are available at the Algansee Branch and if we don't have what you are looking for we can have it shipped in from another library.

# What is the Friends of the Algansee Library?

The Friends group provides support to the Algansee Library, which is a branch of the Branch District Library system, helping through purchase items such as: craft supplies, books, and programming materials. They also host programs and assist the librarian with various activities.

The Friends Group began on April 10, 2001 with 6 members.

In June 2001, we began the process of formalizing the group by applying for a Federal ID number and becoming a 501(c)3 non-profit organization. The Friends received their preliminary 501(c)3 status on April 15, 2002; our formal approval was received on February 11, 2006.

The Friends Group does a number of fundraisers including a book sale in June that is also tied in with a community wide garage sale. In the fall we collect black walnuts that are turned in for money.

Any donations received by the Friends Group are tax deductible and go directly back to programs and books to be used for the library.
