Overdrive – Allows you to download Audio and E-books by going to woodlands/overdrive.com or clicking on the "O" icon on the library website.

Mango – Language instruction – Need help learning another language log into this link "m".


Tumblebooks – E-books for kids, symbol on library website is a book turned at an angle.

What is the Friends of the Algansee Library?

The Friends group provides support to the Algansee Library, which is a branch of the Branch District Library system, through helping to purchase items such as: craft supplies, books, and programming materials. They also host programs and assist the librarian with various activities.

The Friends Group began on April 10, 2001 with 6 members.

In June 2001, we began the process of formalizing the group by applying for a Federal ID number and becoming a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization. The Friends received their preliminary 501(c)3 status on April 15, 2002; our formal approval was received on February 11, 2006.

The Friends Group does a number of fundraisers including a book sale in June.

Any donations received by the Friends Group are tax deductible and go directly back to programs and books to be used for the library.
