

Significant Events of 1998

In May of 1998, Branch District Library became a <u>depository</u> for <u>Michigan documents</u>. That means that one copy of each item issued by a department of the state of Michigan will come to us free of charge. These documents include reports, statistics, books, posters and other "publications." We are required to keep them for at least 5 years and may circulate, catalog or otherwise handle them as we choose, as long as they are available to the public.

The Michigan Documents section is on the second floor. Barbara Riegel, the director's secretary with the help of Sonja Harris and Richard Hutchins, has done an excellent job of organizing, labeling, and listing the documents. We welcome the public's use of these valuable materials. Questions about the availability of Michigan documents may be addressed to the reference staff..

The other important development was the submission of a Library Services and Technology grant, funded by the Federal Institute of Museum and Library Services; and awarded by the Library of Michigan. Although written in 1998, notification of the award came in February of 1999. Next year, we will report on the completion of the grant: to catalog and put all of Algansee and Sherwood collections on our unified county computer system, and to bring Internet access to these two rural branches. Stay tuned for our next report. We express our thanks to Bruce Guy, Automation Librarian for his hard work on this significant improvement in our services to Branch County.



Children's Services

Reading was "DINO-MITE" in 1998 for Branch District Library System. Central Library and Quincy Branch offered Storytime and craft programs to over 2,000 children. Bronson, Union, and Sherwood branches also started offering Storytime programs. Branch District Friends of the Library did fund raising for the System's Summer Reading Program and donated numerous picture books to the Bronson, Union, and Sherwood Branch collections.


