

- On October 31, the library had a booth at the Coldwater Haunted Forest. Unfortunately, due to inclement weather, the event was closed early. We are continuing to work hard to have a library presence at any local event that will allow us to come. - I was approached by Diane Pridgeon several weeks ago in regards forming a Branch County Children's Choir. They were in need of a space to meet for a limited time (six weeks). Luckily we were able to make our schedules work and allow them to meet here at the library. They are using the 3rd floor meeting room later in the afternoon when most of the staff in the workroom are already gone for the day, limiting disruption.
- On November 15, the Coldwater Branch will be holding a program on the paranormal investigation held at the library last month. This is yet another instance of the library working with a local group; another tiny step in the "community building" aspect of the library.
- I've been working on job descriptions/postings in preparation for next year.
- Branch visits continue. This month I've visited Bronson, Algansee, Union and Quincy.
