Materials are defined as books, audio-visuals (such as audio books and DVDs), and periodicals. In looking back through several years of budget vs. actual spending, one can see that actual spending has been less than budgeted; 2014 is the first time budgeted equaled actual spending.

In looking at the budget numbers for 2009-2016, it is important to remember that the Coldwater numbers are usually higher than the other branches. This is normal because funding for databases and for different programs, such as the iPod program (2008-2010), come from Coldwater's budget, and all branches benefit from this strategy.

Tracking actual spending is the best way to predict the budget for the following years. One reason we have not been spending the budgeted amount is because we cannot hold that volume of physical materials within our buildings. We have, as promised, dramatically increased spending on materials after the passage of the millage. However, there is no point in having a large materials budget if it is not going to be spent—we do not want to buy just to buy; better to budget smart and be able to create a useful budget that will meet the needs of the district library.
