

- Bronson Branch:
 - Request to spend endowment funds reserved for the Bronson Branch to purchase 20 STEM activity kits for use in afterschool programs. These kits were a hit at this year's Science Olympiad and cover topics on physics, magnetism, chemistry, logic, and computer science. Total cost: \$435.91. The A. Barnett fund currently has just under \$30,000 available for the Bronson Branch to use.

Requesting \$225 from the recent donations in memory of Beauchamp and Swift, designated for use at Bronson, and \$210.91 from the A. Barnett fund.

- Request from the Bronson Branch Advisory Board to spend \$5,025 from the A.
 Barnett fund to replace 48 interior fluorescent lighting fixtures with LED fixtures.
 Work to be completed by Ludwick Electric, Bronson.

 - Samantha Buterbaugh of Biz-Aid, the Coldwater-based community recycling center, has been our recycling partner at the library for many years. The Branch Conservation District, along with Biz-Aid, is seeking \$14,500 for a local match for a state grant from the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality. This grant would go toward purchasing a large compactor/bailer to help Biz-Aid to increase their local services.
