There was a brief discussion of how the BDL and staff are doing. Numbers are generally down over the same period in 2019, but that is to be expected. There has been good mask compliance from patrons. The

Alganssee Branch is the only branch which, so far, has had to make patrons wait for someone to leave before they could enter because of the size of the branch. Programming is on a break right now while staff gear up for beginning it again in a few weeks. Several video programs are already in the pipeline. Director Rucker and Board President Jewell explained that we do not anticipate any serious budget issues related to the economy during this pandemic. In fact, we might see an increase in revenues from property taxes because the current market is favoring buyers. It was good to see and hear from several of the branch managers since the Board has missed out on our annual meetings at each branch. Staff were praised for their great work during the last several months.
