



To conform with the latest epidemic orders from MDHHS and MIOSHA, and guidance from the CDC, the following changes were made to our [COVID-19 Response and Reopening Policy](#):

- Stage 3, Section F (page 9): the duration of quarantining materials was changed from 72 hours to 24 hours.
- Stage 4, Section E (page 10): the requirement for staff to wear face shield when conducting curbside service was removed.
- Stage 5, Section E (page 11): the lower age of those required to wear a mask was changed from 5 to 2.
- Stage 7 was moved to new stage 8 (page 13).
- A new stage 7 was added (page 12) to cover the situation of the fading pandemic.

As I'm sure you've heard, the governor has set all epidemic orders to expire on June 22. This will allow us to get our facilities closer to normal. However, MIOSHA has not yet updated their rules for employers, so there will be no changes to staff protocols just yet. Monday, I am attending a webinar on these latest developments with our library lawyer, Anne Seuryneck, and the Library of Michigan, and will report anything new at the meeting Monday evening.
